

# **CLASSROOM POLICIES FOR DISTANCE LEARNING**

When you are in a Zoom classroom, the following policies will be in place:

- You should be in your uniform for your Zoom meetings if you are Zooming into a class where your classmates are in uniform.
- You should be in appropriate attire according to our distance learning dress code if your whole class or the whole school is learning at home.
- You should be seated in a chair in a reasonable environment, not lying on your bed or otherwise more casually positioned.
- Please take care that the background of your Zoom call is appropriate and not too personal.
- Attendance will be taken, and you should be on time as you would be to class.
- You are expected to keep your video on during Zoom calls, unless there is an emergency in the room at home.
- Avoid distracting environments as much as possible.
- Though we may be unable under most distance learning circumstances to ask you to *serve* a detention, detentions will be issued as usual and there will be similar serious consequences for those who accumulate too many detentions, in keeping with our student handbook.
